



Seongjusa Temple Site (Historical Site No. 307)

Seongjusa Temple, is the best garam of Nine Mountain Zen Gates in the late Silla Dynasty, boasts its grand scale and history, where about 2,000 monks practice asceticism. Stele for Buddhist Monk Nanghye, where Choe Chiwon's writings are carved, is the best stupa in the late Silla Dynasty and the early Goryeo Dynasty, which was designated National Treasure No. 8. ⚠ 72, Seongju-ri, Seongju-myeon

As Korea's first coal museum, this teaches the origin and history of coal.



Ungcheon Stone Park

Learn everything about the historic "nampo oseok," which is used as a royal tombstone since it does not change even after 1,000 years passes.


